Entry Fee: \$400, NON-REFUNDABLE. Make checks payable to AYWC and mail to Lance Opitz/ 803 22nd Ave NE/ Aberdeen, SD 57401. Checks due within one week of entry. Entry fee includes admission for members of the official roster submitted for this event; maximum of 25 wrestlers grades K-8 (20 weight classes with 5 alternates), 3 coaches and 2 table workers. All wrestlers need to be a member of your club within your school district. No all-star teams allowed. Any exceptions must be approved by the tournament director.

Weigh-in and registration: Weigh-in and registration will take place between 5:00 and 7:00 pm on Friday, April 9th, 2021 in the NSU Barnett Center. Each team will need to arrive together for weigh-ins. Weigh-ins will be done by team with each individual athlete wearing a singlet or appropriate undergarments.

Admission: Adults \$10, students \$5; 6 & Under Free - Full concessions will be available

Coaches meeting: The coaches meeting will be held at 7:30 AM on Saturday, April 10th.

Team introductions: Teams will be introduced at 7:45 am Saturday, April 10th. Competition will begin immediately following.

Weight Classes: 47, 50, 53, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 77, 82, 87, 93, 100, 110, 120, 130, 140, 150, 170, HWT (Max 250)

Pool matches: Round 1 8:00 am/Round 2 9:30 am/Round 3 11:00 pm/Round 4 12:30 pm/Round 5 2:00 pm/Bracketed Round 1 3:30 pm/Bracketed Round 2 5:00 pm/Championship Match 6:30 pm

Awards: Winning team will receive a championship belt and each participating member on the championship team will receive a pair of **custom fight shorts**. Members of the 2^{nd} place team will each receive a beanie. Championship match will be wrestled under the spotlight on a $52' \times 52'$ mat.
